

Further Information regarding bouncy castles:

Comberton Village Hall does allow bouncy castles in the hall but have experienced several problems with such equipment recently so have introduced conditions to hirers bringing in such equipment.

Our public liability insurance does not cover hirers or their guests for any damage or injuries arising out of use of bouncy castles in the hall, so you must ensure that your bouncy castle provider has suitable public liability insurance in place.

Generators must be placed on suitable mats or other protective floor coverings as they have caused serious damage to the wooden floor, and you must ensure that the castle is of a height that will not, during its erection or use, knock the overhead projector which is suspended from the ceiling. The height from the floor to the projector is 3 metres.

Please be advised that all or some of your deposit will be retained if any damage is caused to the floor and/or overhead projector as a result.
