Supply of alcohol for consumption ON the premises only	Monday-Sunday Non Standard Timings: On no more than three occasions each year the hall will be permitted to stay open until 0115 and the supply of alcohol will be permitted until 0030 hours. This is to allow the Village Hall to be booked for special occasions (e.g. New Year's Eve). All outdoor licensable activities shall cease by 23:00.	Noon	11:30pm
C. Indoor sporting event	Monday-Sunday Further details: We have never had any sporting events to date, but wish to cover ourselves should there ever be an initiative by EHDC to put on events in village halls or if anyone wants cricket, indoor football, table tennis, or badminton events.	9:30am	11:00pm
D. Boxing or wrestling entertainment (Indoors & Outdoors)	Monday-Sunday Further details: We have never had such an event but one may possibly happen at the country fair one year.	9:30am	11:00pm
E. Performance of live music (Indoors & Outdoors)	Monday-Sunday Further details: Bands playing at Country Fair in May. Variety performance with village talent. Concert parties (private) with music. Live bands for parties indoors. Non Standard Timings: On no more than three occasions each year the hall will be permitted to stay open until 0115 hours and live music will be permitted until 0030 hours. This is to allow the Village Hall to be booked for special occasions (e.g. New Year's Eve). All outdoor licensable activities shall cease by 23:00.	9:30am	11:30pm
F. Playing of recorded music (Indoors & Outdoors)	Monday-Sunday Further details: Music with films shown indoors, discos at parties and weddings. Recorded music as background for plays or entertainment evenings. Non Standard Timings: On no more than three occasions each year the hall will be permitted to stay open until 0115 hours and recorded music will be permitted until 0030 hours. This is to allow the village hall to be booked for special occasions (e.g. New Year's Eve). All outdoor licensable activities shall cease by 23:00.	9:30am	11:30pm
G. Performance of dance (Indoors & Outdoors)	Monday-Sunday Further details: Morris dancers occasionally at Country Fair in May. Children's dancing in variety at Maypole and shows or perhaps adult displays of specialist dancing (line dancing), barn dance and reels and ballroom.	9:30am	11:00pm
