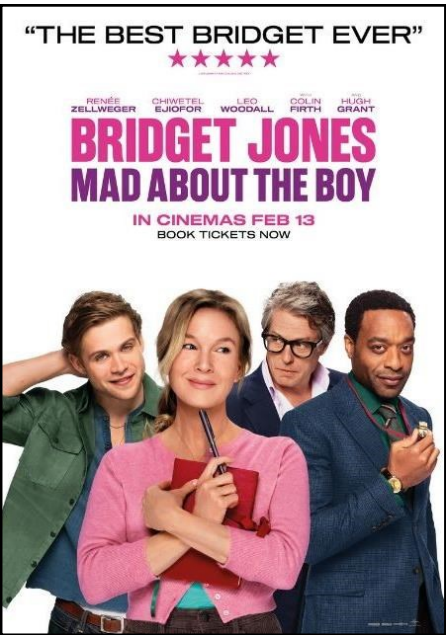
Summer is here!
