



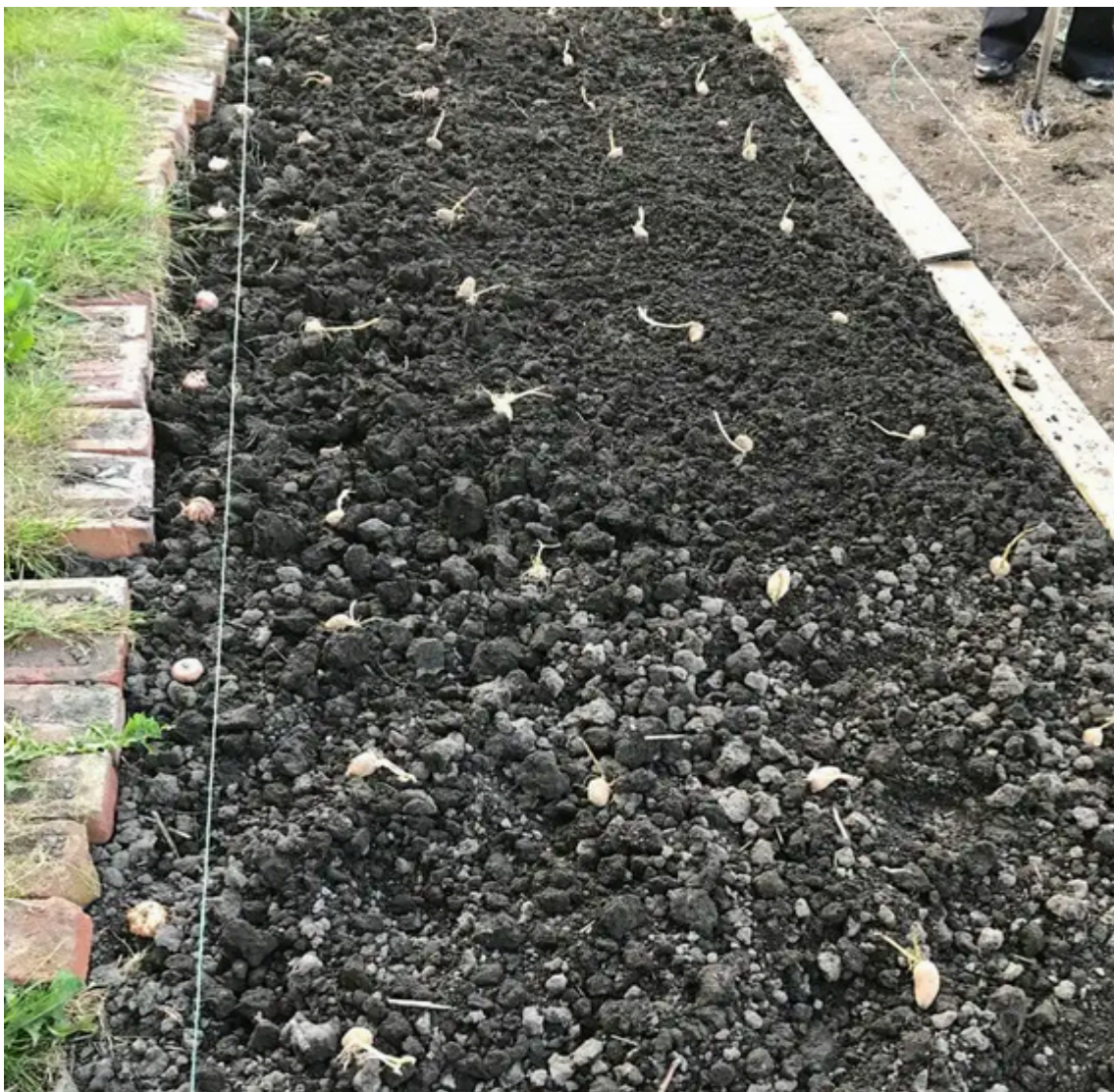
Community Allotment

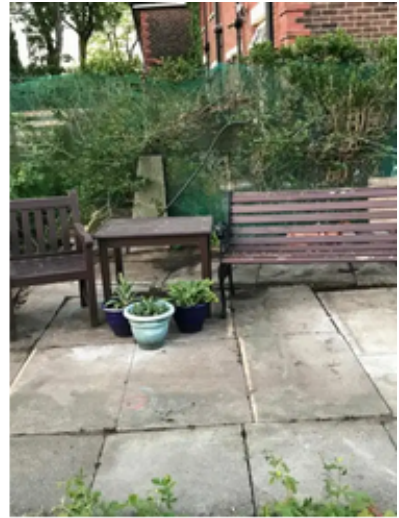
2019 saw our allotment really flourish (sorry for the pun!). We really saw the project develop in to its own with parts of our vision finally being realised.
