Blunsdon Community Shop AGM



Caretaker Vacancies

Blunsdon Parish Council is seeking two part-time Caretakers to support the upkeep of our community facilities and help deliver our vision of a clean, safe and attractive parish. These roles cover a variety of parish spaces including the Village Hall, Pavilion, Recreation Grounds, Play Areas, Community Building and the new Multi Use Games Area (MUGA).

Details of the Role

- 10 hours per week, flexible working pattern
- £13.47 per hour
- One role to start as soon as possible, with the second commencing in August when the MUGA opens

Main Responsibilities

- Cleaning and preparation of venues for bookings and general use
- Safety checks including fire alarms, emergency lighting, playground equipment and site security
- Litter picking and general tidying of outdoor areas
- Minor repairs, furniture setup and porterage
- Unlocking and locking venues and assisting with viewings for hirers
- Reporting maintenance issues and supporting energy efficiency initiatives
- Liaising with members of the public, contractors and councillors as required

- Willingness to undertake training as needed (e.g. Health & Safety, equipment checks)

Linley Road Refurbishment – Multi Use Games Area (MUGA)

The extra parking that we have needed for the village is now done and the ground work finished on the new courts and pitches. We will add some signage to Sams Lane to direct visitors to the parking areas which hopefully will ease the matchday congestion in Sutton Park. Also, it should help with school pick-up and drop-off congestion.

The technical work on the fencing and surface is now being completed. As soon as the courts and pitches are safe and up and running, we will set them up for booking through the Parish on-line booking system. (https://blunsdonparishcouncil.co.uk/page/village-hall) There will be two, five-a-side pitches and two full size tennis courts available to hire from 5pm until 9:30pm weekdays and from 9am to 9pm at weekends. We anticipate the first bookings will be available in September.
