



Wales & West Utilities is undertaking a £120,000 project to upgrade gas pipes in Old Town over the coming months.

An inbound closure from Croft Road to Devizes Road was put in place earlier this week (30 June) ahead of Devizes Road fully closing to traffic on 21 July.

The utility company estimates that the work will finish by the end of September.

We have been working closely with businesses directly in the area to help mitigate any impacts, including waiving café pavement licence fees.

A diversion route will be in place and access for businesses and residents will be maintained.

### Greenbridge roundabout work completed



Work to refresh the road markings at Greenbridge roundabout has been completed.

Alongside this work, the Council's team also carried out some patching work to fill gaps that had appeared in the road's surface. The work will help to extend the life of the roundabout and help reduce further deterioration.

In total, £55,000 will be spent on refreshing road markings this financial year, as part of an overall investment of more than £5m into local roads. This investment includes resurfacing work, planned maintenance, traffic light maintenance and new street lighting.

For the summer season (July, August and September) there are three walking trails across the Borough to get you out and about. These are:

- The Robin trail – a loop from the Moredon Sporting Hub

- The Pig trail – along the Eastern Flyer from Greenbridge to Swindon Town Centre

The trails are short and take in areas of nature, heritage and art.

Here are some roadworks scheduled to take place over the next few weeks:

- **Manchester Road - now to 25 July**

- **Croft Road, Old Town - now to 18 July**  
Wales & West will partly close the road for repair works
- **Devizes Road, Old Town - now to 10 October**  
Wales & West will close the road for repair works
- **Albert Street, Old Town - 9 July**  
Vodafone will close the road for utility asset works
- **Shrivenham Road, Highworth - 21 July to 8 August**  
A contractor will install traffic lights for kerbing and resurfacing work
