# Hello Brian and Speedwatch Team Blunsdon!

I carried out 3 sessions on 19/05/2025 on Ermin St junction with Minerva Heights, Sams Lane and outside the Heart in Hand in High Street and 10, 5 and 1, drivers respectively have been issued with notices of intended prosecution for excessive speeding.

The roads monitored are 30MPH and 20 MPH and the fastest vehicle was captured at **44 MPH** Depending on previous convictions and history

# Drivers will be offered a speed awareness course or face £100 fine and 3 Penalty points

# 1 Driver will face £100 fine and get 3 Points.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place, which includes checking for MOT, Insurance & Point Totters.

Captured footage will be analysed for other offences like seat belts and mobile phone use.
