Proposed restructure of the MAC

The Directors have initiated a consultation process with the team about a new operational structure for the MAC to tackle our next challenges:

- While the growth in users and activity in the past twelve months has stabilised our financial position, the MAC needs to generate more revenue to cover ongoing repairs and renewals of the building and facilities
- We need to develop and promote new activities to take full advantage of the recent and forthcoming improvements to the Sports Hall and Outdoor Court
- Our current structure isn't flexible enough to cover staff absence. We're reliant on volunteers and Directors to step in at short notice and at times we're even having to close, which isn't acceptable to members and customers

We're therefore considering the appointment of a full-time manager to oversee both commercial and day-to-day operations, and the implications of that for members of the team. We've spoken with each team member individually and will continue the consultation process fairly and sensitively over the next two weeks.

In the meantime, Lucy Wright has taken on day-to-day management to guide the MAC through an especially busy period of several functions and the much-anticipated installation of our new all-weather artificial pitch on the site of the tennis courts.
